Secondly of claims paid out what % are to those who are type a and those who are type b? What % of each class have been rejected?"

We can confirm that Post Office does hold the information you have requested.

Please find the attached eligibility criteria for the Horizon Shortfall Scheme Fixed Sum Offer (Annex A).

Post Office can confirm that there is no difference in how cases are assessed for current and former postmasters. Please find below a breakdown of the cases processed so far, indicating the applicant's eligibility and whether a Horizon-related shortfall has been identified.
