In your email, you have requested the information shown verbatim in bold below:

I don't know if I should be asking you or Royal Mail, but what is the expiry date for Queen Elizabeth II stamps (if any) and how should they be exchanged? While I did exchange most of my non-barcoded stamps, I do still have a few odd ones (mostly low-value changemaker stamps).

While I don't have any stamps with odd halfpence, what is the procedure for either using or exchanging such stamps and can odd halfpennies still be added together?

We can confirm we do not hold the information you have requested. Post Office separated from Royal Mail Group ("Royal Mail") on 01 April 2012; therefore, we do not have access to information held by Royal Mail, including the requested information.
